#### BERNHEIM

Hints of toffee, berries, and spice

#### BRADSHAW BOURBON

Roasted nuts and vanilla on nose and palate, finishing with hints of black pepper and a waft of smoke

#### **BUFFALO TRACE**

Pleasantly sweet with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit and anise

#### BULLEIT

Mid-palate is smooth with tones of maple, oak, and nutmea

#### BULLEIT 10YR

Consistently smooth taste with vanilla, dried fruit

#### BULLEIT RYE

The taste is exceptionally smooth, with hints of vanilla, honey, and spice

#### CALUMET 10YR

Abundantly textured with bursts of toasted honey and oak

#### COOPER'S CRAFT RESERVE

Caramel, Cotton Candy, Citrus Fruit & Cinnamon

#### DAVID NICHOLSON RESERVE

Honey, butter, and vanilla a hint of floral notes. The finish is short but deep in barrel spices and pecans.

#### EAGLE RARE

Bold, dry and delicate taste with notes of candied almonds and very rich cocoa

#### ELIJAH CRAIG

Smooth and warm, pleasantly woody with accents of spice, smoke and nutmeg

#### EVAN WILLIAMS BIB

Citrus on top of vanilla & black pepper

#### EVAN WILLIAMS S.B.

Lush and spicy, oak with honey, apple and orange notes

#### GEORGE DICKEL BIB

Deep & delicious enhancing the oak

#### HEAVEN DOOR RYE

Rich with vanilla upfront, with chocolate syrup, and green oak. Short finish shifts to astringent oak, with spearmint, and baking spices.

#### HEAVEN DOOR TN BOURBON

Smooth and lasting with notes of vanilla and baked bread layered over toasted oak.

#### JACK DANIELS RYE

Well rounded flavors of sweet caramel and dry baking spice followed by a peppery rye character finish

#### JEFFERSONS RESERVE

Butterscotch, raisins, spicy and red pepper flavor notes

#### JEFFERSONS SMALL BATCH

Burnt caramel, cinnamon heavy spice, dark fruit leather, honey soaked baklava, pie crust and a touch of wood

LARCENY

Buttery caramel and honey, with a rich mouth-feel

REDNECK RIVIERA

Rich, full palate complexity with approachable sweetness, followed by honey dark stone fruit essence

TEMPLETON RYE

Hint of caramel, butterscotch, toffee and allspice

LINCLE NEAREST 1856

Spicy caramel up front with the proof, hints of maple then mellows with dried fruit and floral notes. Sweetness and spice reminiscent of freshly baked oatmeal raisin cookies

YELLOWSTONE SELECT Smoked caramel

1792 SINGLE BARREL

Rich butterscotch & caramel notes, balanced with hints of fruit and toffee

1792 SMALL BATCH

Spice minales with sweet caramel and vanilla

BASIL HAYDEN

Spicy & light-bodied with a gentle bite

BELLE MEADE

Caramel and vanilla with bold rve spice and hints of apricot

BELLE MEADE RESERVE

Oak, bread, spicy and cocoa flavor notes.

CHATTANOOGA CASK STRENGTH

Bold, sweet and spicy approach with a rich, tull body

CHATTANOOGA 1816 WHISKEY

Balanced sweet and spicy oak character with a medium body

CHATTANOOGA HIGH RYE

Toasted graham cracker, cherry cola, and spice. More sweet than spicy.

JEFFERSONS RYE COGNAC FINISH

Spice of the rye is bevelled with orange, peach and honey giving a full-bodied mouthfeel.

KNOB CREEK RYE

Bold rve spiciness with undertones of vanilla and oak

KNOB CREEK SINGLE BARREL

Deep and complex flavors of vanilla, nuts and oak

KNOB CREEK SMALL BATCH

Rich, sweet, woody, full-bodied...almost fruity

#### AMERICAN BARRELS BOURBON

A combination of caramel, vanilla, and barrel finish dark cherry

#### ANGEL'S ENVY

Vanilla, ripe fruit, maple syrup, toast and bitter chocolate

#### BAKERS

Toasted nuts, fruits, vanilla, & silky texture

#### CLYDE MAY'S BOURBON 92PR

Wonderfully soft with complex aromas of barrel spice, fruit, and oiled leather

#### CLYDE MAY'S RYE

Spice & Citrus on the palate

#### CLYDE MAY'S WHISKEY 85PR

Warm, medium-bodied spirit with accent of black pepper and hints of anise and toasted oak

#### FOUR ROSES SINGLE BARREL

Hints of ripe plun & cherries, robust, full body, mellow

#### FOUR ROSES SMALL BATCH

Mellow, ripened red berries, dried spice, well-balanced, rich

#### HIGH WEST DOUBLE RYE

Rye spices up front, then menthol, mint, eucalyptus, herbal tea with wildflower honey and all spice

#### HIGH WEST PRAIRIE

Rich and earthy with well-balanced flavors of candy corn, honey nougat and sweet corn bread biscuits

#### OLD FORESTER 1870

Baking spices flowing into a citrus–fruit mix and shortbread sweetness

#### OLD FORESTER 1897

Deep fruit, spice and oak notes layered over dark caramel and vanilla

#### OLD FORESTER 1910

Caramel coats layers of malt nuttiness and sweet graham cracker all warmed by green peppercorn and coriander spice brightened with a hint of cedar

#### OLD FORESTER 1920

Caramel coats layers of malt nuttiness and sweet graham cracker all warmed by green peppercorn and coriander spice brightened with a hint of cedar

#### RUSSELL'S RSV RYE

Sweet floral notes at first. The flavor continues with rye fruitiness, burnt sugar, hard candy cherry flavor barnvard hav, and concentrated lime

#### RUSSELL'S RSV SINGLE BARREL

Rich, creamy toffee and vanilla taste

#### RUSSELL'S RSV SINGLE BARREL RYE

Spicy pepper, vanilla and tobacco flavors

#### RUSSELL'S RSV SMALL BATCH

A rich, caramel and vanilla taste

Subtle notes of candies spices and citrus

Brown sugar and a slight hint of barrel spices

Custard, baking spice, grass, and black pepper


WILDERNESS TRAIL
